The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 19<sup>TH</sup> day of August in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, knowing that an official proceeding or investigation was in progress or was about to be or likely to be instituted, and with purpose to mislead a public official who was or might be engaged in such a proceeding or investigation, or with purpose to corrupt the outcome of any such proceeding or investigation, made, presented, or used a record, document, or thing, to wit: A COURT DOCUMENT, which the said

TRACIE HUNTER knew to be false, in violation of Section 2921.12(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

# SECOND COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 19<sup>TH</sup> day of August in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, with purpose to defraud or knowing that she was facilitating a fraud, forged a writing, to wit: A COURT DOCUMENT so that it purported to have been executed at a time or place or with terms different from what was in fact the case, in violation of Section 2913.31(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

# THIRD COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 22<sup>ND</sup> day of August in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, knowing that an official proceeding or investigation was in progress or was about to be or likely to be instituted, and with purpose to mislead a public official who was or might be engaged in such a proceeding or investigation, or with purpose to corrupt the outcome of any such proceeding or investigation, made, presented, or used a record, document, or thing, to wit: A COURT DOCUMENT, which the said TRACIE HUNTER knew to be false, in violation of Section 2921.12(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

## FOURTH COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 22<sup>ND</sup> day of August in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, with purpose to defraud or knowing that she was facilitating a fraud, forged a writing, to wit: A COURT DOCUMENT so that it purported to have been executed at a time or place or with terms different from what was in fact the case, in violation of Section 2913.31(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

#### FIFTH COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 2<sup>ND</sup> day of April in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, a public official, knowingly authorized, or employed the authority or influence of her office to secure the authorization of any public contract, to wit: AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT, in which TRACIE HUNTER, a member of her family, or any of her business associates had an interest, in violation of Section 2921.42(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

# SIXTH COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, from on or about the 25<sup>TH</sup> day of July, Two Thousand and Thirteen to on or about the 30<sup>TH</sup> day of August, Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, a public official, knowingly authorized, or employed the authority or influence of her office to secure the authorization of any public contract, to wit: AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT, in which TRACIE HUNTER, a member of her family, or any of her

business associates had an interest, in violation of Section 2921.42(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

# SEVENTH COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 6<sup>TH</sup> day of November in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, a public official or party official, knowingly committed a theft offense, to wit: THEFT OF UNITED STATES CURRENCY, and the property or service involved is owned by HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND/OR THE HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO JUVENILE COURT, in violation of Section 2921.41(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

### **EIGHTH COUNT**

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that TRACIE HUNTER, on or about the 20<sup>TH</sup> day of November in the year Two Thousand and Thirteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, a public official or party official, knowingly committed a theft offense, to wit: THEFT OF UNITED STATES CURRENCY, and the property or service involved is owned by HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND/OR THE HAMILTON COUNTY OHIO, JUVENILE COURT, in violation of Section 2921.41(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.
