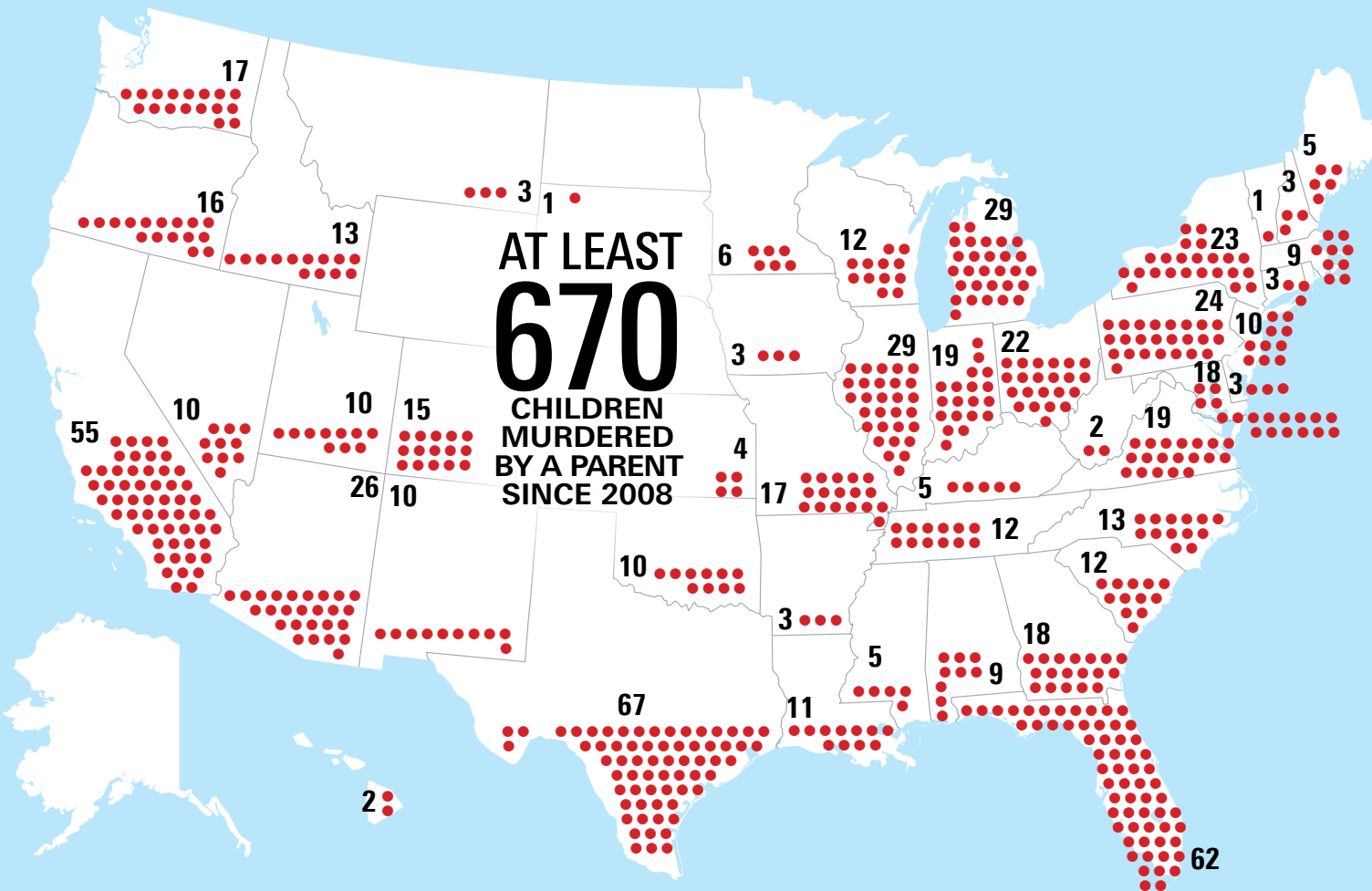

At least 670 children have been murdered by a parent involved in a divorce, separation, custody, visitation, or child support situation in the U.S. since 2008.

Abusive parents are often granted custody or unprotected parenting time by family courts — placing our nation's children at ongoing risk.

Researchers who interviewed judges and court administrators following some of these tragedies found that **most believed these were isolated incidents**. Needed reforms have not been implemented.

Many court-related child homicides occurred after family courts **granted dangerous parents access to children** over the objections of a protective parent.

#1 The safety and well-being of children should always be the first priority in child custody and visitation cases.
